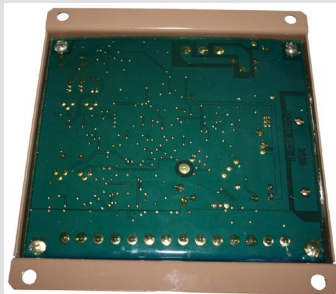
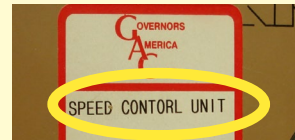
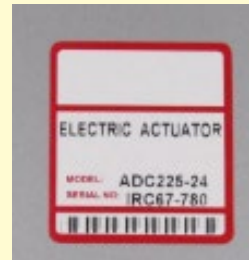

- ☞ High-quality components, seals, connectors, and workmanship is the reason you buy GAC



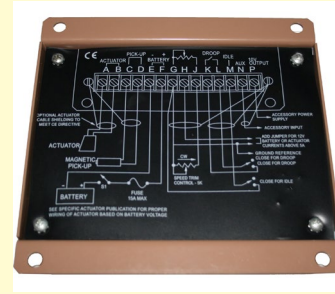
FAKE



- ☞ No GAC logo
- ☞ Proudly U.S.A. is never a bar code
- ☞ Look for misspelled or incorrect naming
- ☞ Low quality connectors and seals



Most GAC products have no back panel, you see the electronics board clearly through a protective coating.



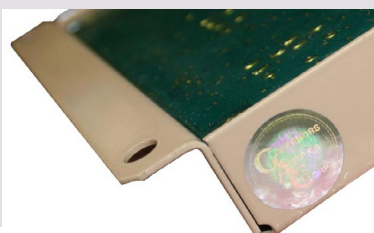
Fake product backs have a wiring diagram or a solid color backing.



This is a correct serial label on the product box. You will note there are two bar codes.



Serial number labels will never look like this.



If you do NOT see a Hologram Sticker, most likely it is a fake.
